Hope you have all had a good year.

Memberships run out on the 31st December. You can renew your membership from now on for 2026.

Remember to go onto the breeders list you must have kittens registered under your name and prefix.

Please note also that all litters must be registered.

To gain titles and points and to enter the Karnak/National Shows you must be a current financial member and your exhibits must be

Registered by the closing date of the show.

Please keep in mind that when using Social Media you are considerate and polite.

When paying Direct to bank you must send me the proof of payment before I can action your applications, this is required by the

Auditor. When paying by credit card please ensure the details are up to date.

Thank you to all who helped at the shows, you are aware by now that I can no longer attend the shows.

To all exhibitors please show respect to the Officiating Judges by not doing any behaviour that will cause a disruption in the ring.

If you feel that something is incorrect then quietly approach the Ring Clerk when the Judge has completed the section.

If still in doubt quietly go to the Masterclerk to check the query. Do not under any circumstances mess around with the paperwork

On the Masterclerk table, wait patiently for the Masterclerk to tell them the concern you have.

To be eligible for the end of year placings you must be a financial member and the exhibit registered. This is compiled upon each

Exhibit being in 8 rings to qualify.

To be eligible for Breeder of the year you must be a financial member and your exhibits registered. This is taken over the highest scoring

5 exhibits entered in the 8 rings. This is taken over cats who may also be considered as kittens and N/S.

i.e. A kitten may be scored if in 8 rings and then when going to cat must also be in 8 rings etc.

The points are then added up by the ring score and then divided by the number of shows entered.

The breed winner is the highest scoring exhibit of that breed over 8 rings.

Remember when getting a cat/kitten from another breeder to keep them isolated from your own cats for at least 21 days.

As cats transferring from 1 home to another can stress .

For those who breed and white please state on your application if they are either Bi-Colour, Harlequin or Van This is for all

Breeds except Ragdoll which already has the divisions Pointed, Mitted and Bi-colour.

If you are unsure of the pattern look at the colour standard in the Standards of excellence.
